What is the Silent Auction All About?

First is our fully inclusive preschool where children with special needs such as autism, cerebral palsy, and Down's syndrome are together side-by-side with typically developing children. The monies help to cover extra staffing as well as training and equipment. The second side to Sharing Lives is tuition assistance for families in need. We are all aware of the financial challenges facing our community and the preschool is able to reach out to those families to help them cover some of the expense of tuition.
