The Friendship Club

The friendship club is a program designed to help children who want to learn how to make friends and play cooperatively. Kindergarten Readiness Program

This program is designed to develop reading readiness and skills in the areas of drawing, coloring, identifying letters and numbers, rhyming, counting, cutting, and pasting. Activities help develop listening skills, following directions, sequencing, story telling, and social play skills. The group will be led each session by a preschool teacher and a licensed occupational therapist or speech-language therapist. **Must be 5 years old by December 2, 2009**

This interactive food and cooking theme based group program was developed to help expand what your child will eat and their willingness to try new foods and/or textures. Goals include, creating positive experiences with food; establishing a meal time routine; increasing the range of foods your child will try; and providing parent education on how parents can positively affect their child's eating habits.

Following directions, vocabulary and sequencing skills are also incorporated into this group. The group will be led each session by a preschool teacher and a licensed occupational therapist or speech-language therapist. **Must be 4 years old by December 2, 2009**
